Unfortunately, we were not able to get a date closer to last years because we are competing with the churches Christmas events along with our own district schedule.

As of right now we are doing everything needed to prepare for the event and are currently seeking a commitment for beverage committee chair to fill the last void in the roster. We are hoping to get one of the local half way houses to step up but there is more discussion needed on this matter. All the other positions have been filled and are currently getting up to speed and finding the support they will need. Not much if anything will change in regards to the overall format so we do not foresee any major issues.

We are formally requesting the support of District 22 for the initial financial support to get this venture under way. We will need a deposit check written to Highland Fellowship Church for \$100.00 with the remaining \$250.00 paid on the day of the event. We will also soon need approximately \$50.00 for fliers and a copy of this year's certificate of insurance for when we sign the rental agreement. At next months district we will present a formal budget. Going off of last years numbers the money needed to match will be slightly higher because we do not have the carryover of materials left over by the Big Book Conference that we had in 09. The number at hand at this time is \$2,695.00 to \$3,000.00.

This number is a total of all the dollars spent by all the committees plus a dollar amount added for the goods carried over from the Big Book Conference and used for the Christmas party. Maggie has graciously donated to District 22 a Santa suit that she purchased with her own money.

We understand that all meetings are autonomous and donating is not a requirement but request that all G S R's discuss at their next business meeting what ever means they have used in the past to collect Christmas party donations. This event has always been a wonderful experience and is looked forward to by many; Let's make this a sober event to remember.

RE: **Yellow Page Listing**

Background: AA District 22 currently is not listed in the local Yellow Pages Telephone Directory for the Elgin and South Elgin area.

The Elgin area Yellow Pages however does include a category entitled "Alcoholism Information and Treatment Centers."

There are numerous listings within this category. The Elgin area "AA in Spanish" is listed, and appears as the 7th listing. If AA District 22 were to list, we would be the 8th listing. There are also a couple of advertisements, one for the Renz Center for credit card payment and another for Lutheran Services.

The next Yellow Pages Directory will be printed and distributed in February 2011. We would need to sign up by December 2010 to be included for the 2011 directory.

Note: We do have an updated and actively current web page.

Question: Do we want to be listed in the local Yellow Pages Directory?

Issues to consider:

1. Cost: The cost to be listed is \$8.50 per month, and the contract duration is 1 year. (\$8.50 x 12 months = \$102 per year)

2. For the first year, our entry would be highlighted in a black box. After the first year, our listing would revert to a regular line item entry.
3. We would also be automatically included in the DexKnows.com Google internet search at no additional cost.
4. Our web address would also be included, at no additional charge.
