1. Due to a change requested by this meeting several months ago, I will not attempt to compare 2013 contributions or expenses to 2012 numbers for the balance of the year. District picnic and district Christmas party reports are separated from the district reports except as they impact the district directly. (Therefore I am including a note in regard to the Christmas party as it may impact the district as a whole.)
2. In November 2013 Group contributions to the district were \$480.00.
3. Expenses in November 2013 were \$590.79.
