Corrections Facility Chair Report

We are willing and available to do workshops, the next one will be in District 23 on October 27th from 1 to 3 pm. Flyers and information are on the website. Your District Corrections Chair also has a copy.

We are planning on visiting any District meetings that ask us to attend. I have visited my home District (23) in August and also District 42 in August.

We have received two inquiries for contacts/literature/AA meeting guidance from prison inmates in Kewanee and in Joliet that have been passed along to District Chairs for help.

The Dupage County Jail had a bit of a hiccup with the outgoing Sheriff, and all volunteers were about to be kicked out. The matter has been resolved and the meetings will continue.

A District asked me to have my pink can total expenditures on the website, so I will send Earl an anonymity protected copy of my reports so that all NIA members can see where their funds are going.

I am currently working on a bid for the 4th Annual National Corrections Conference for our Area, Area 19 and Area 21, making it hosted by the entire State of Illinois. I have costs, prices, and am working on putting a nice bid together.
