LITERATURE AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

A new edition of the catalogue for the purchase of Conference-approved literature is now available. For the first time, it includes AAGrapevine materials as well as those books, pamphlets and other materials purchased from AAWS.

The first AAWS eBooks, the Big Book and <u>Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions</u>, will be available for purchase through the "AA Online Store" on the AA website around November 15th. An AA mobile app for use on handheld mobile devices to allow purchased copies of these books will be available at no cost. An Apple version (iPhone, iPod and iPad) will be available first, followed by one for most Android powered devices. The price for these first two eBooks has not yet been determined.

AAGrapevine's website (<u>www.aagrapevine.org</u>) has been redesigned and allows for the purchase of print and online subscriptions and other materials. PayPal is now available as a payment option. For the first time, stories are being published exclusively to the

web site. As a result more stories will now be published each month than could be published in the print magazines. The web site will be updated frequently, allowing for new, original stories each weekday. A new Grapevine Complete subscription combining the magazine and online features is now available. New hard copy books, Step and Emotional Sobriety II are now available for purchase on line. Grapevine is also currently developing eBooks, beginning with Language of the Heart.

MEMBERSHIP SURVEY

Fifteen groups in Northern Illinois (14 English- and 1 Spanish-speaking) were randomly selected to participate in this year's membership survey. I have forwarded the completed survey forms that I received from these groups on to the GSO. The results will be published in the pamphlet "Alcoholics Anonymous: 2011 Membership Survey."
