Today's presentation will be the abridged format, modified to fit within a 30 minute time slot. Then, after the Treasurer's report and a quick update from Rich H. (Area Inventory), we'll move directly to <a href="New Business">New Business</a> which will include a discussion on bids for the 2019 ISC, and then motions which have been put forth by the Corrections Committee (2), Electronics Equipment Committee (1) and one from a Group in D52.

After lunch, we'll hear a final report from the 2018 Spring Assembly Conference committee and then an update from the 2018 Big Book committee.
